Deep ripping field walk

After deep ripping plant roots typically have better access to water and nutrients, and that has implications on fertiliser requirements. Despite having a good biomass response to ripping there are some years with a dry finish that deep ripping has a yield penalty. Can we manage that yield penalty by managing nitrogen supply? Does deep ripping allow crop roots to grow quicker and catch up with leached nitrogen?

Paul Blackwell and Bill Bowden will explore crop responses to different depths of ripping with and without topsoil incorporation during the field walk.
