Participants will gain an understanding of a variety of different systems and species utilised in this part of South Africa.

This trip will offer an opportunity to do just this with a group of likeminded individuals, outside the borders of WA. - Sustainable pastures with maximum 'green root days' (green roots all year round)
- Winemaking, including cover crops in vineyards
- Seafood experience
- A visit to Groenkloof at Darling where Australian Merinos originated from and medic pastures
- Karoo National Park, expert in natural veldt (pasture) and management of
- Indigenous forest of Knysna including a boat trip to Featherbed
- Caledon to see the Swartrivier Dohne Stud, biological farming operation
- Whale watching in Hermanus
- Free day in Capetown for shopping prior to departure home
- Plus a game park, of course!
