Perennial Pastures Galore!

The Department of Agriculture and Food of WA have established a trial site on Parsons Road during 2015, consisting of various perennial pasture species. The plot looks great after some terrific autumn rains, and the 11 different species with multiple cultivars that are exhibited, are well worth looking at before they are harvested for yield monitoring. Perennials are most valuable to the farming system with out of season growth, and this year has been a great example.
