

Changes

RCSN - DELIVERY Local validation of research findings plus extension and communication GRDC are always evolving. Changes include:

- No external tender process currently for RCSN projects
- New reporting formats
- Bigger emphasis on project design (statisticians?) and economic evaluations
- Preferred suppliers list

DELIVERY (1-3) Investment Portfolio

- Regionally and locally focussed delivery of APPLIED – Regional Investment areas: Agronomy, Farming Systems, Nutrition, Soils, Weeds, Pests/Entomology, Pathology (3-8) and RCSN activity
- Validation, extension and communicatione.g. NVT, RCSN, Research updates, Groundcover, Grownotes.
- Requires regional infrastructure and capacity
- Needs to be able to measure effectiveness

Challenges

- Call them opportunities!
- Changing landscape & the speed it happens
- Rising costs
- Access to good technical and professional people
- Burn-out and chasing dollars
